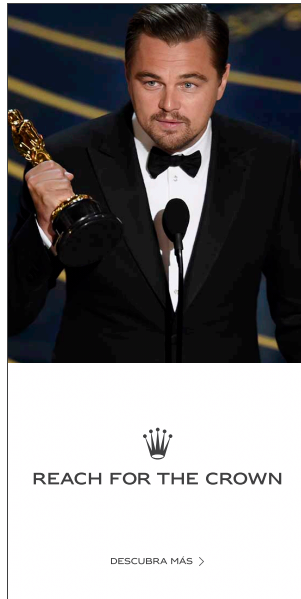
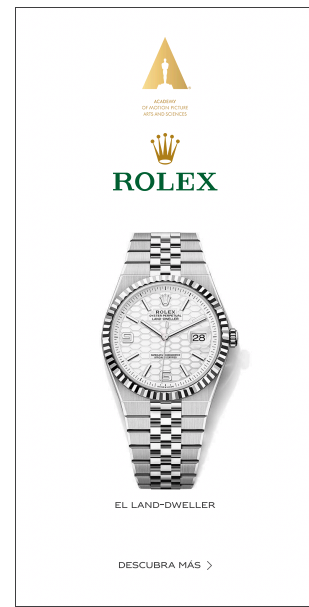

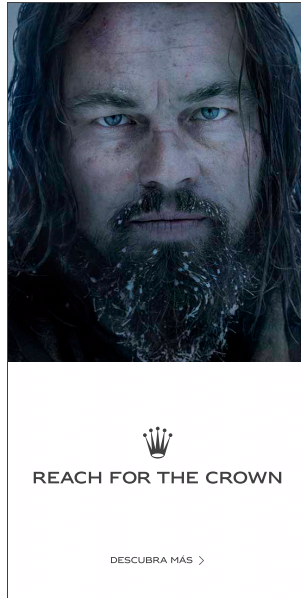


This was the fourth edition of the festival.
